Our month dedicated to Advent included candle lighting, devotional sharing from church family, and a special Advent material from Langham Foundation HK called "Coming King".



教會生活營-大冒險 2024 Church camp – A Big Adventure

我們共有 47 名教會家庭成員參加了 2024 年4 月 教會為期三天兩夜的夏令營。主題 是大冒險 A Great Big Adventure 。這次營會 籌委會主要由青少年組織,並由一位新任 執事監督。我們很高興發現他們的潛力和 在耶穌里的友誼。

什麼是冒險?冒險是指使您面臨受傷或損 失風險的行為,無論大小。我們想鼓勵我 們的會眾向耶穌和彼此敞開心扉,並體驗 新事物。



例如;對於某些人來說,他們可能不喜歡和一群人一起過夜;有些人可能害怕住 在馬槽般的住宿中,有些人可能從未去過營會,有些人可能從未負責準備營會 ,有些人可能需要請假休息一天。這些都是可能令人退縮的原因,但參加這個 營會的人已經克服了這些障礙。當你願意走出去,嘗試冒險時,你會看到自己 的進步,看到上帝的恩典是多麼豐富和出乎意料。

We had a total of 47 church family members join our 2024 CCMA church life camp in April. A mix of families attended the three days and two nights camp. The theme was the journey of A Great Big Adventure. This camp was mainly organised by teenagers supervised by a new deacon. We are pleased to find out their potential and friendship in Jesus.



What is an adventure? Adventure means an action that puts you at risk of injury or loss, big or small. We want to encourage our

congregation to open their heart to Jesus and each other, and experience new things.

For some people, they may not like staying with a group of people overnight; some may be afraid to live in a mangerlike accommodation, some people may have never been to a camp, some may have never be in charge of preparing a camp, and some people may need to take a day off. These are all reasons that can be intimidating, but the people who participated in this camp have crossed in the face of these obstacles. When you're willing to step out and try to take risks, you'll see yourself improving and see how abundant and unexpected God's grace is.



May God continue to guide and grow our church family to love Him more, and be disciples making disciples.

The past year has been an exciting one for our ministry. I think that's normal when you're on mission for Jesus!

We've been fortunate in being able to welcome a new cohort from the Children's Ministry. It's been great to see how they have integrated into our ministry and have become more involved in the things we do as the year has progressed.





It's also been encouraging to see our church family invite their friends to come along and experience life as fellowship together and worship Jesus. It's God who adds to our numbers, but He gives each one of us the responsibility to make invitations. It's been great to celebrate this happening in our church family life.

Our church family is also growing older. A number have entered the life stage of heading into marriage and parenthood – we celebrated one wedding and a few engagements, and it's been an interesting challenge to see how we follow Jesus through different life stages!

During the year we have focused on a few topics including prayer, what is the sabbath, the discipleship journey and have used the Alpha material for the first time as part of our Sunday services.

A highlight for many of us was taking part in the church camp. It was great to see a number of our younger folk stepping up to help in making the camp a success!

Our mid-week meetings continue to evolve, and we have a high level of engagement. Of course, we want everyone to take part in these meetings and are always looking for ways to encourage even higher involvement.







It was also great to see events like the Basketball competition organised by Jonathan Wong in September. We hope for more events like these to bring friends along, as well as creating more bonding time within our church family. Despite the boys' best efforts, the Chinese team took the win!

Children Ministry – Ada Leung

We would like to acknowledge all the volunteers, including parents and teens who have put in effort to become role models to the children in our church family. The Lord remembers your love and care to equip the next generation.

This year we continue to adhere to our church theme of disciples making disciples. We're grateful to have new volunteers join in discipling our children as they grow. This includes Ann, Yitong, Candy, and Melody stepping up. Praise God for answering our prayers from last year!



We also have had a few combined services with English Ministry. We had Good Friday Service at the staffroom together in April; a special Puppet show from guests Trinity Puppeteers in July, and the recent Father's Days Service in September.





We pray that children from a young age understand how to make wise decisions for themselves, so we continue to challenge pre-teens to personalise and own their faith. The booklets 'Growing Young Disciples Series' by Tim Hawkins has been a great resource for the oldest group. Throughout the year, we also held a few Bible quizzes to bring out their healthy competitiveness of bible knowledge.

In the beginning of the year, we have had some newcomers join us but have not stayed: Erwin, Hemmie, Karmia's family.

Some have joined us more regularly, including Katya and Yanice (as their family immigrated from China to live in NZ). They both bring high energy and girl power to our primary Group C!



Proverbs 11:25 says it best "The one who blesses others is abundantly blessed; those who help others are helped.'

In Ecclesiastes 3, it mentions there is a season for every thing. A time to serve, a time to build, a time to heal, a time to rest. Stepping down doesn't mean I stop serving altogether. It's an opportunity for others to step up. God is able to equip anyone to do His good work. He was able to equip me—an arts graduate with little experience—to do His good work.
